EFMN has developed guidelines to support individuals holding DIY Fundraisers. Since these are not EFMNsponsored events, the guidelines are in place to ensure legal compliance and assist you in your process.

STEP 1: Setting up your DIY	 Review this document for EFMN DIY guidelines Complete the DIY Fundraiser Proposal Form Email/fax to <u>kolufson@efmn.org</u> or 651.287.2325 EFMN will review each DIY proposal
STEP 2: Promote	EFMN will provide our logo for use on promotional materials and flyers All materials for events must be reviewed and approved <u>annually</u> All materials must include: "PROCEEDS SUPPORT THE EPILEPSY FOUNDATION OF MINNESOTA"
STEP 3: Awareness and Promotion	EFMN will add the event to our online calendar EFMN will share monthly social media posts directing followers to DIY listings EFMN <u>must</u> approve all printed materials with EFMN logo prior to distribution Contact EFMN for educational resources to share at your event

Donations & Charitable Tax Deductions

For donations to be eligible for a charitable gift tax deduction, they must be made directly to EFMN Checks should be made payable to the **Epilepsy Foundation of MN** Include the DIY name on the memo line To receive donations via credit card, the DIY organizer may work with EFMN on available options EFMN is not able to accept registration fees associated with an event or provide any "pass-thru" funds EFMN strongly encourages events with registration fees to create a personal bank account EFMN's 501(c)(3) status may <u>not</u> be used in opening any accounts EFMN is not able to receive or track any registration information EFMN's 501(c)(3) status may <u>not</u> be used to request auction/giveaway items or grant applications
